EURO 2008 SWELLS UEFA COFFERS BY \$394 MILLION!

UEFA has earned a record \$250 million (US\$394 million) from the 2008 European Championship.

European football's governing body said that is an increase of \$27 million (US\$42 million) from Euro 2004, and would be enough to pay for its youth and women's competitions until 2012 as well as refereeing and coaching programs.

The rest of the proceeds will be distributed amongst UEFA's 53 members.

UEFA reported that actual turnover during threeweek tournament in Austria and Switzerland was a staggering US\$2.04 billion (\$1.3 billion), with more than half the money coming from the sale of broadcasting rights.

At least 155 million people watched each of the 31 matches live on television, UEFA said.

The cost of staging the event grew from \$313 million in 2004 to \$600 million (US\$943 million).

GALAXY'S GULLIT RESIGNS, LALAS OUT

Los Angeles Galaxy, who are captained by England midfielder David Beckham, were dealt a blow when the team's head coach Ruud Gullit resigned for 'personal reasons'.

Ruud Gullit has been replaced by first-year assistant coach Cobi Jones.

In a related move, Galaxy President Alexi Lalas, instrumental in luring Beckham to the Major League Soccer (MLS) club in July last year, has also been fired from his job.
