## N. Cafcaros: World at her feet

Dancing for her country is only the beginning. Nicola Cafcaros, 7, has aspirations of playing the violin while dancing on the moon.

he Hillsdale resident has been singing, dancing and playing the violin since she was three years old and is about to dance her way around the world.

Nicola has been chosen to

represent Australia in the Dance World Cup in Jersey, Channel Islands, on June 23, and in the Hall of Fame Dance Challenge in Florida, USA, on July 4.

It is not only the first time an Australian team has been represented in the Dance World Cup, but also the first time a seven-year-old has competed in the event.

Nicola, whose dance styles include ballet, jazz and song and dance, will be performing

three solo acts in both events. She said she was looking forward to representing her country.

"I don't get nervous because when I dance it makes me so happy and I make the audience happy, too," she said.

"I enjoy being tested and judged on my solo and group dances."

Her father, Alex Cafcaros, said the Americans were amazed at his daughter's capabilities.

"They said, 'You can't sing and dance at the same



time - you mime'," he said.

"I had to explain she could do both and they were amazed because they had never seen someone of Nicola's age be able to do both."

Nicola, who is in Year 2 at St Spyridon College, Kingsford, said she hoped to combine three careers when she grew up.

"I want to be a rocket scientist, dancer and violinist," she

said. "I would like to dance and play the violin on the moon."
