OBAMA JOINS US BID FOR WORLD CUP

In the same way our PM Kevin Rudd has endorsed our own World Cup Bid, so too has President Barack Obama lobbied the head of international soccer on the United States' bid to host the World Cup. He has even expressed the desire to attend the upcoming contest in South Africa. Obama met with FIFA president Sepp Blatter at the White House to discuss the United States' prospects to attract the tournament in 2018 or 2022. Blatter then invited Obama to attend the World Cup in South Africa in 2010, and Obama said he'd like to make that trip.

"You know, I hope to," Obama said to reporters as he walked back toward the West Wing after a separate event. "We're going to take a look at the schedule." Blatter said he heard the same message during their closed-door meeting, which included some soccer moves in the Oval Office. Obama bounced the ball on his foot, "making two, three movements, and then he took it to his head," Blatter said.

Asked how Obama did, Blatter said the move "merits a compliment." He then added Obama is not ready for United States' team that almost defeated Brazil. Blatter presented Obama with a soccer ball from that Confederations Cup match, which saw the U.S. team lose 3-2 after leading 2-0.

The entire soccer movement in the United States could receive a tremendous boost if the 2018 or 2022 World Cup is awarded to the Americans. FIFA will decide in December 2010, with England considered the front-runner for 2018.

Blatter has expressed a preference for bringing the tournament back to Europe after stints in Africa and then South America, where Brazil will host the 2014 World Cup. The United States is one of 11 countries that has formally declared its desire to host either event, while Netherlands-Belgium and Portugal-Spain have submitted joint bids.

Football Federation Australia (FFA) has announced a program for the Oantas Socceroos involving seven matches over the next eight months as they prepare to participate in the 2010 FIFA World Cup in South Africa, as well as secure qualification for the 2011 AFC Asian Cup. The seven matches will be played at home, with Sydney Football Stadium set to host the number 3 team in the world, the Netherlands, in an international friendly on Saturday 10th October.

Last September the Qantas Socceroos defeated the Netherlands 2-1 in Eindhoven courtesy of a Harry Kewell penalty and a Josh Kennedy header. The only other time these two nations faced each other was in June 2006 when the Qantas Socceroos drew 1-1 with Netherlands in Rotterdam in the lead up to the 2006 FIFA World Cup. Four days later, the team plays a crucial AFC Asian Cup qualifier against Oman at Melbourne 's Etihad Stadium. Australia currently sits fourth in their AFC Asian Cup qualification group and it is vital that the Qantas Socceroos make the most of the double FIFA break.

The third home game will be played at Brisbane 's Suncorp Stadium on 3rd March 2010 in another AFC Asian Cup qualifier against Indonesia. The four remaining matches for the Qantas Socceroos involve two international friendlies and two further AFC Asian Cup qualifiers. The Qantas Socceroos will meet Ireland in Limerick (Ireland) in just under a weeks time, as well as Korea in Seoul on 5th September in friendly matches. The AFC Asian Cup matches involve Oman in Muscat on 14th November and Kuwait in Kuwait City on 6th January 2010.
