Stone structures of Lesbos

Photographer Tzeli Hatzidimitriou's illustrated coffee-edition book featuring centuries-old stone structures on the eastern Aegean island of Lesbos are published in a poignant album entitled "Conversing with the Spirits of the Stone: Agricultural Architecture of Lesbos".

Stone, wood and mortar -- the humble building materials of rural Lesbos -- are depicted in Hatzidimitriou's photographs for the first time, in a sojourn across the large island.

The album also presents Lesbos' landscape, dotted with stone structures representing the occupations of the local residents and imbued with the island's aura, mostly in sites off the "beaten track".

The pictures are accompanied by texts referring to the traditions behind the building of these structures, written by the photographer herself.
