“Football NSW supports Australia’s bid to host the FIFA World Cup in either 2018 or 2022.

FFA are required to secure 64 training sites and Belmore Oval would naturally be one venue to be considered in the mix.

Belmore Oval is located in the Canterbury District Soccer Football Association which is one of the most culturally diverse Football Associations in Australia.

The training sites have detailed requirements which one would expect of an event of the magnitude of the FIFA World Cup. The training site agreement runs for more than 33 pages.

The training venue must be of adequate construction quality, equipped with state-of-the-art technical and logistical facilities and comply with FIFA’s technical, security, infrastructure, equipment and other requirements. There are a number of media and marketing rights associated with training sites which need to be assigned to FIFA.

Canterbury City Council has obviously undertaken an assessment of the work required to bring Belmore Oval to the standard required by FIFA. They would have reconsidered the economic benefits to the municipality and the strategic priorities of the Council.

They have made a judgment call. Unfortunately it was not the way we would have liked it. However, the Councilors are responsible to the rate payers, and they need to be comfortable with the decision they have made.

Naturally Football NSW is disappointed. We are disappointed for the local Football Association, particularly one which is culturally diversified as Canterbury. We do accept the right of Council to make the decision they have and respect the democratic forum in which they reached their decision.”
