⇒ **GRAND FINAL FEVER HITS SYDNEY!**

The Hyundai A-League 2010 Grand Final between Sydney and Melbourne will be broadcast live across Asia, the Middle East, the UK and Ireland, Africa, and North America.

Season 5 of the Hyundai A-League has seen coverage increase significantly with live matches and highlights packages gaining widespread distribution across the globe.

While Fox Sports (Premier Media Group) and Sky Sports cover Australia and New Zealand, FFA has negotiated for both live matches and highlights packages to be broadcast during the Hyundai A-league 2009/10 season throughout the Pacific territories through the Oceania Football Confederation TV sub-license rights holders; via Fox International in North America, the Middle East and Africa; BskyB in the UK and Ireland; and in Asian territories on the Football Asia program produced by World Sports Group and via i-Cable to Hong Kong and Pan Asia.

“The Hyundai A-League 2010 Grand Final has the potential to reach 79 million households across the globe through the affiliated networks we have negotiated broadcast deals with,” said Head of Hyundai A-League Archie Fraser.

“Football is the world game and for the Hyundai A-League to get this kind of exposure is further proof of the growth and development of our game. On a local basis alone the television audience that witnessed the Sydney FC v Melbourne Victory semi-final second leg at the SFS (Sydney Football Stadium) reached an average TV audience of 177,000 in Australia alone,” continued Fraser.

“In only five years we have established ourselves in the fabric of the world sporting culture - the popularity of the Hyundai A-League both in Aus-

tralia and abroad are key to the success of the competition. This will be the biggest match of the season and for it to be telecast to such a vast audience is another big step in the progression of football in Australia .”

Perth Glory vs Gold Coast United

Perth Glory Youth will play Gold Coast United this Saturday at Etihad Stadium for the National Youth Championship. Kick-off is at noon (AWST). Perth Glory Youth qualified for the Grand final after finishing the season in second place on the table before beating Adelaide United 1-nil in Sunday's semi-final at Clipsal Stadium, Inglewood .

SOCCEROOS vs USA

The United States will play Australia in a friendly in South Africa on June 5th, the Americans' final game before their World Cup opener against England a week later.

The U.S. Soccer Federation said that the match will be played at Ruimsig Stadium in the Johannesburg suburb of Roodepoort. It will be only the third matchup between the nations following a 1-0 Australia victory at Orlando, Florida, in June 1992, and a 1-1 draw at San Jose, California, in November 1998.

The game could produce a matchup of U.S. attacker Clint Dempsey facing his Fulham teammate, goalkeeper Mark Schwarzer, and American goalkeeper Tim Howard and midfielder Landon Donovan going up against Tim

Cahill, their teammate at Everton this season.

It also involves rival nations trying to win rights to host the 2018 or 2022 World Cup.

The 18th-ranked U.S. plays the No. 25 Czech Republic at East Hartford, Connecticut, on May 25 and meets No. 41 Turkey four days later at Philadelphia before travelling to South Africa, where the Americans are in a first-round group with eighth-ranked England (June 12), 27th-ranked Slovenia (June 18) and 32nd-ranked Algeria (June 23).

Australia, ranked 23rd, is in a first-round group with fifth-ranked Germany (June 13), 28th-ranked Ghana (June 19) and 13th-ranked Serbia (June 23).

Qantas Socceroos Head Coach Pim Verbeek said that this match was crucial for his team's preparations for the tournament. “The USA are a very strong team and of course will be participating at the FIFA World Cup. They narrowly lost to the Netherlands recently, which shows their qualities, so this match will be very good preparation us, Their style of play will allow us to test our players against similar opposition to what we will face at the World Cup,” concluded Verbeek.

The FFA is also in the process of organising another international friendly match for the Qantas Socceroos in South Africa prior to the 2010 FIFA World Cup with details to be announced once finalised.

St George are at home against Fraser Park who will be lead around the park by player/coach Ante Juric. Fraser Park were very lucky not to have been relegated last season after finishing last-rescued only by the disappearance Penrith Nepean United.

Central Coast Lightning head to Ernie Smith Reserve on Sunday, where they will be entertained by FC Bossy, who will also be looking for a better 2010 than what they enjoyed last year.

The last game on Sunday sees Granville Rage at home to Sydney University.
