Jackman has joined actress and fellow Australia co-star Nicole Kidman in publicly supporting Australia's efforts to bring the FIFA World Cup to their home country.

The Wolverine star and sports lover is confident about Australia's chances of success and points to the sporting passion of his countrymen as a major selling point.

The FIFA Executive Committee will make a decision on the hosts for the FIFA World Cup™ in 2018 and 2022 on 2 December 2010.

her country is committed to hosting a safe World Cup and visitors can expect to "go back home safe and happy."

Maite Nkoana-Mashabane says South Africa has committed money and resources so the tournament is the best "the world has ever seen." She said Monday the country is enlisting the help of more than 24 countries and Interpol.

The World Cup runs from June 11th to July 11th and will be in Africa for the first time.

Nkoana-Mashabane says her country is especially honoured to host the tournament, given its history with apartheid.

RONALDINHO TO PLAY IN WORLD CUP?

Ronaldinho thinks he can persuade coach Dunga to include him on Brazil's World Cup roster.

The AC Milan star played in the last two World Cups but hasn't appeared for Brazil since a World Cup qualifier against Peru in April 2009.

In a recent article published on Wednesday in the weekly publication "Chi," Ronaldinho predicts he will be a member of the team and says Brazil will win its sixth World Cup title.

"I will go to the World Cup, and I will win it," Ronaldinho was quoted as saying. "Recently, I have had problems with the national team, but it hasn't been my fault. I can't imagine a World Cup without Ronaldinho on the field.

"It seems impossible to me when I think of not playing," he added. "I feel bad, really bad. Therefore, I can safely say I will make my country proud in the World Cup and, above all—with my teammates—I'll win it."

Despite Ronaldinho's good form with AC Milan, most observers doubt Dunga will select Ronaldinho, the 2004 and 2005 FIFA player of the year.

Brazil was knocked out by France in the 2006 World Cup quarterfinals despite a lineup with many of the world's top players.

"It's not about big names anymore," Dunga has said repeatedly.

MORE SOCCEROOS IN A-LEAGUE

More Qantas Socceroos and other high-profile Australian players will play in the Hyundai A-League after a initiative announced by Football Federation Australia (FFA).

Clubs will be able to use an Australian Marquee Player option for the upcoming Hyundai A-League 2010/11 season to compliment the current Marquee Player system.

Clubs will now have the ability to sign a top Australian player in addition to the current Marquee Player system enabling them to carry two (2) top class players outside the salary cap.

FFA will arbitrate transfers based on a Marquee Standard that assesses criteria including a player's number of national team appearances, international/national profile, and other factors considered by FFA to be relevant including individual club's financial circumstances.

"There is a wealth of Australian talent overseas with over 140 players currently playing in 15 of the top leagues in world football," said FFA CEO Ben Buckley. "Australian players are com-

peting at a high level in Europe, Asia and America and what we have created is a viable option for these players to return to the Hyundai A-League and compete in what is becoming a very strong and competitive league.

"This initiative will boost the depth of the playing squads and create tremendous excitement around our competition. Our continuing success in the AFC Champions League has the spotlight directly on the Hyundai A-League and the inclusion of an 'Australian Marquee' allows clubs to bring home our top stars to continue to compete at a high level in Australia and Asia."

Hyundai A-League clubs will also have the opportunity to sign a 'Guest Player' who falls outside the 23-man Hyundai A-League roster allowance for up to a maximum of 10 matches which can now include the Hyundai A-League Finals Series.*

To promote an improved Hyundai A-League as well as developing Australian talent the five (5) foreign player rule will remain intact.
