Vanessa Panousis shoots for the stars

The Sydney Comets have landed. They are the first female basketball team from NSW in years to take out the 2010 National Junior Classic.

After coasting through the preliminary rounds undefeated, the Alexandria-based team met the much-favoured Melbourne Tigers in the final, winning 50 to 33.

Star point guard Vanessa Panousis, of Kingsford, led the team with 30 points and, for her efforts, is this week's Junior Sports Star.

It was the Comets' best finish in the Classic in the past three years (the previous best was fifth). But this year has brought some great results for the team, including winning their Sydney club competition.

Vanessa's father, Peter Panousis, said the girls' present good form was a result of a period of development, top coaching and player commitment.

Vanessa, 15, has been playing basketball for eight years, after following her brother in-

to the sport.

The high school student has also had senior Women's National Basketball League teams express interest, but she is keen to reach for the stars.

"I want to play for a college in America and see where that takes me," she said.

Vanessa has been nominated for the Cumberland-Courier Junior Sports Star award, which is sponsored by Rebel S-

The Junior Sports Star of the Year will receive a medal and \$1000, and the Young Achiever will receive a medal and \$500.

Grecian robes for kids

A NEW store importing colourful kidswear from Greece has just opened in Craigie.

Marie Madamadiotis started Acropolis Fashions at Craigie Plaza after receiving numerous compliments about her own children's clothing.

"With my husband being Greek, his family used to send clothes for our kids and people kept asking where we got them from because they were so different," she said.

"So I decided to take the step of opening a shop to see what happened."

Acropolis Fashions is the only shop in Australia to stock Greek label Energiers, and Mrs Madamadiotis already has plans to expand the business. A buying trip to Greece is planned for September and she has booked to attend a trade fair in Melbourne this August with a view to selling the clothing wholesale to boutiques across Australia. The shop caters for boys and girls in sizes from newborn to age 16, and Mrs Madamadiotis said the clothing had a quality and style unique to Greece.

"The colour blends they use are a lot differ-

'Antikythera Mechanism' exhibition opens on Kythera

The exhibition on "The Mechanism of Antikythera" will be on display on the southern Aegean island of Kythera on Aug. 11-Sept. 19 at the initiative of the ministry of education. The formal inauguration will take place on Aug. 11 in Potamos, Kythera and on Aug. 19 the exhibition will open in Chora, the island's main town, to run until Sept. 19.

The visitors of the exhibition will learn about the history of the mechanism believed to be an ancient mechanical calculator (also described as a "mechanical computer") designed to calculate astronomical positions.

It was discovered in the Antikythera wreck, off the Greek island of Antikythera, between Kythera and Crete, and has been dated to about 150-100 BC. Technological artifacts of similar complexity appeared a thousand years later.
