Following last year's success, a second Australia-wide version of the film festival for students of the Modern Greek language is to be held.

The competition will take place in October this year in Melbourne as part of the Greek Film Festival in Australia. The event is a collaborative effort between the Antipodes Festival and the Education Office of the Consulate General of Greece in Melbourne with the support of the Victorian state government's Department of Education and Early Childhood Development.

The festival will be open to

classes, groups of students or individual students from all schools in which the Modern Greek language is taught. This year participants from all states and territories of Australia are cordially invited to attend. The short films must be produced under the supervision and guidance of a teacher. The central theme of the competition will revolve around the notion of a "Journey in Hellenism". This can encompass a physical journey through space and time, a journey of emotion and imagination, or a fusion of both. It can for example allude to Greek Community life, Religious concepts and practices,

cultural events, the migratory experience, social, family and school life or and other notion or experience that invokes Hellenism or Greekness. It may also entail a culinary journey through the diverse tastes of the Greek cuisine, or perhaps a musical and/or dance journey. Regardless of the nature of the journey, it needs to be linked to Greece and to briefly capture the Greek Australian experience – whether this be through the lens of the first, second or third generation.

The entry may be in the following formats: fiction, animation or documentary. The duration of the film should not be

longer than four (4) minutes and must primarily use the Modern Greek language.

The competition will include four (4) categories for participants:

- primary school students in grades 5 – 6
- secondary school students in years 7 – 9
- secondary school students in years 10 – 12
- Tertiary students.

In each category three (3) monetary prizes will be awarded as follows: 1st prize \$400, 2nd prize \$300, 3rd prize \$200. In addition every competitor will receive a certificate of participation.

The criteria for assessing the films will be as such:

- a) Creativity and imagination
- b) Use of language and
- c) Quality of both picture and sound.

Each of the above 3 criteria will be equally weighted. Those students, classes or groups wishing to participate in this exciting initiative, now in its second year, may express their interest by completing and submitting the attached entry form by the 30th April 2011.
