\$100,000 reward for information following sexual attack on Bourke nurse

Minister for Police and Emergency Services, Michael Gallacher, has today announced a reward of \$100,000 for information concerning a sexual attack upon a nurse in Bourke last year.

At about 7pm on 25 March 2010, Kirsten Williams was on her nightly exercise walk around the township of Bourke when she noticed two, possibly three, male occupants in a red sedan following her.

The 26-year-old nurse was struck on the back of the head with an unknown object and was dragged by two men into a laneway off Coomah Street where she was held down and sexually assaulted.

During the attack she was also punched in the face and head, and her wrist was dislocated.

The attackers were frightened off by an approaching car and Ms Williams was able to run to a nearby home for help.

Despite extensive inquiries during the past 14 months police have been unable to identify those responsible for the assault upon Ms Williams, who is the daughter of a long-serving local police officer, Sgt Mick Williams, APM.

Kirsten, a mother of three, today bravely spoke out about her ordeal and joined police in making a public appeal for information.

"I honestly thought I was going to die that night and I still have nightmares about what happened," Ms Williams said.

"This is my home town and it saddens me to think this could happen to anyone here.

"And it saddens me that there may be people with information who haven't come forward because there is a possibility that they (the offenders) are from this community.

"I just want to know who did this to me so that I can finally begin to put this behind me." Her father, Sgt Mick Williams, said he was confident those responsible will ultimately be identified.

"I would urge anyone with information to break their silence and come forward so that Bourke, too, can begin to heal because this has been a devastating incident for the entire community, not just my family," Sgt Williams said.

Darling River Local Area Commander, Detective Superintendent Michael Thomas, said the overwhelming majority of residents have been outraged and dismayed by this cowardly attack.

"The Williams family is well-known and respected within this community and the assault upon Kirsten was an affront to every decent resident of Bourke," Supt Thomas said.

"I would urge anyone with information about any aspect of this matter to come forward and contact police – even any-

mously via Crime Stoppers – so that we can bring to justice those responsible."

Police have re-issued Comfits of two men, both described as being of Aboriginal appearance.

The first man is described as aged between 17 and 25 years, about 160-170cm tall of thin build.

The second man is also described as being aged between 17 and 25 years; about 170-185cm tall, and of a muscular build.

Supt Thomas said police also wanted to speak to anyone who may have information about a late-model red Ford Falcon sedan which was seen in Bourke on the night of the attack. "It is possible the occupants of that red car were not involved in this incident but may be witnesses who hold another piece of the puzzle that can help us solve this crime," Supt Thomas said. Anyone with information is asked to contact police via Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000.

Man charged after indecent assault - Liverpool

A man has been charged following an alleged indecent assault at a doctor's surgery in Liverpool.

Police have been told a 17-year-old girl attended a doctor's surgery on Bigge Street, Liverpool, about 6.30pm on Sunday 8 May 2011, where she was allegedly indecently assaulted by an 84-year-old man.

She attended Liverpool Police Station the following day (Monday 9 May 2011) and reported the matter.

About 9.50am on Tuesday 24 May, the man was arrested by detectives from Liverpool Local Area. He was charged with assault with act of indecency and given conditional bail to appear in Liverpool Local Court on 17 June 2011.

Police appeal for information after robbery - Guilford

Police from Rosehill Local Area Command are investigating an armed robbery at Guilford this morning.

Witnesses have told police about 8.55am (25 May), four men approached a delivery van on Guilford Road.

The four men, who were wearing balaclavas, threatened the delivery driver before stealing cigarettes.

The cigarettes were loaded into a white van and the men then drove from the area.

No one was injured and no weapons were sighted. Police were alerted to the incident and attended shortly after, establishing a crime scene. A number of road blocks have been put in place and a canvass of the area is underway. Investigating officers are now seeking public help as they continue their inquiries.

In particular, police are searching for a white van bearing NSW registration plates 'ASJ 01Y'. Police believe the registration plates have been removed from another vehicle. Anyone who witnessed the robbery or who has information in relation to the incident is being urged to Crime Stoppers on 1800 333 000.

If anyone sees the van they should not approach it but call 'triple zero' immediately.
