The Shop Gallery 112 Glebe Point Road Glebe



The Shop Gallery is a new space for artworks and installations on Glebe Point Road in Glebe. It had its first show in November 2014. The owners are artists and writers who have their own studios on site and who hire out the space for artists and curators to run their own shows. The building was formerly a local institution, The Cornstalk Bookshop, that sold antiquarian and 2nd hand books. A back shed accommodated the book binder Newbold and Collins who have since moved to Yagoona whilst Cornstalk has continued as an online bookseller. The shed has become a sculpture workshop.

The building has been renovated to provide two large rooms facing the street that can

be hired out singly or together. The owners want to provide an accessible space for artists to have complete management of their own exhibitions, so artists or curators set up the shows, provide gallery minders and do their own openings. So far there have been 3 group shows and one solo show by Dina Tourvas, Portraits of Women.

The grand opening show in February was a week-long group show of more than 40 artists, run by the owners themselves. People were invited to bring in an artwork of their own choosing and hang it themselves.
