

Keeping our tradition but building our Future Board Elections Cyprus Community of NSW

This coming Sunday 19 May 2015 the members of the Cyprus Community of NSW have an important choice to make at the election of directors for the next two years. One of the candidates running on Sunday for the board is the Deputy Mayor of Randwick Councillor Anthony Andrews.

Councillor Andrews has been an active member of the Cyprus Community for over 20 years with his late grandfather being a founding member. Councillor Andrews also served previously on the board in 1999-2000 where he held the position of Assistant Secretary.

Councillor Andrews has been a Councillor for over 15 years and over the last two years was elected

to the position of Deputy Mayor. Councillor Andrews has been responsible in ensuring that Randwick City Council is now debt free and one of the leading councils in NSW. Further to this he has successfully managed budgets in excess of \$140 million.

Councillor Andrews said "there is a lot at stake on Sunday, noting the current financial situation of the club. Unless something drastic happens the Cyprus Community will cease to exist as we know it today. It was only last year that the previous board needed to borrow money from a member who is also a Director for the club to pay for daily expenses. During the last two years the previous board has spent \$713,000 to get a development approval, which is not proceeding.

Councillor Andrews said "My knowledge and experience would be an asset to the Club noting my proven track record on Council noting my delivery of both infrastructure and services to my local community. If elected on Sunday I will ensure the Community has a short and long term financial plan in place to ensure that we have a presence not just now but in the future for our children and grandchildren to enjoy. On Sunday I call on my fellow members to come and vote for myself and my team which consists of Tony Lofitis, Andrew Philippou and Andrew Efthimiou. Let's keep our tradition and build our future".
