 Political Poems and Dramatic Monologues

Direction and adaptation by Vrasidas Karalis, readings presented by Athanasia Costa and Eleni Eleftherias-Kostakidis.

This homage to Yannis Ritsos' poetry presents some of his most significant political poems written during the 1947-1974 dictatorship, which castigate the loss of individual freedom and of political independence. As well as short poems from his *Repetitions*, *Testimonies* and *Parentheses*, the presentation includes his monologue *Chrysothemis*, dedicated to the sister of Electra, an existential exploration of the psychology of the "little people" overcome by historical events beyond their control and by dominant personalities beyond their understanding. The selection highlights the diversity of Ritsos' poetic language and the complexity of psychological realities encapsulated in his verses.
