served there was Stella Miles Franklin, one of your state's most famous writers. Her experiences in the Scottish Women's Hospitals in Thessalonike and the area of Lake Vergoritis (then known as Ostrovo) inspired writings that are still highly regarded Twenty-five today. later, the Second Generation ANZACs returned to those same battlefields in northern Hellas. this time to defend democracy against the Nazi invaders. Outnumbered and outgunned, the Anzacs were forced to retreat down the mainland and across the Aegean to the island of Krete. Following a heroic stand, some were evacuated to Egypt. However, over 5,000 Anzacs were left behind as prisonersof-war, the second largest such group in Australian history. Your reputation as a long
