STATHAKOPOULOS:



Having published a collection of personal narratives, or war stories, with the book, 'Between the Shots and the Silence: Hellenes at War (World War II and Korean War) in 2016, Sydney historian, Vasilis Vasilas, continues to discover the last of that generation of war veterans. While he has been recently gathering personal narratives from Sydney's current Greek shopowners, he came across all sorts of stories. So, it was not a surprise when he interviewed the Stathakolpoulos family who have run George's Takeaway in Padstow for over 47 years that Theodoros Stathakopoulos served in the Greek Army and was sent to Korea. Here are his experiences during his national service and his tour of duty in Korea:
