THREE BEST GOALS 3. SAM KERR'S BRILLIANT CHIP

The Chicago Red Stars scored in the first nine minutes of the game and not surprisingly, it was from the foot of Sam Kerr. **Chicago was** on the counter and the ball was played to Kerr at the top of the box, she had a strong touch that forced her run to go almost endline.

But when it seemed Kerr had no angle for a goal she perfectly chips the ball into the back of the net. This reminds us all that Kerr can do the impossible.

2. LATE WINNER FROM INDIANNA ASIMUS

The Wyoming Cowgirls were down 1-0 late in their game against South Dakota. What looked like a loss for Wyoming they were able to net a late goal earning themselves the tie.
